 - b. Read all article options
 - c. Decide as a group which of the following topics to research
- Wondering
 - a. Questioning: Focus on a topic
 - i. Narrow Topic by manageable chunks
- Webbing
 - a. Searching: Create a search strategy for identifying useful information
 - b. Identify possible resources in informational articles, videos, or other resources
 - c. Cite your sources that are optional in your presentation (need at least FIVE SOURCES for BIBLIOGRAPHY)
- Wiggling
 - a. Evaluating: Use and evaluate information resources
- Weaving
 - a. Synthesizing: Process information
 - b. Review the gathered information and decide how it will be used in presentation
 - c. Continue to cite your sources that will directly be used (at least THREE SOURCES for WORKS CITED)
- Wrapping
 - a. Creating: Select and develop a product-PowerPoint, Google Slide, Prezi, Thinglink, Gloster
- Waving
 - a. Communicating: Present to an audience
 - i. All group members must have a speaking part during the presentation
- Wishing
 - a. Assessing: Assess project and reflect on the process
